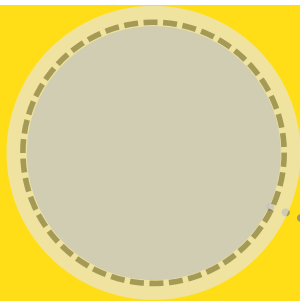


Stay connected, make a plan, gather supplies.



GENERATOR SAFETY

Follow the **20-20-20** rule:

Power up SAFELY with generators.

If using a generator during a power outage, follow these tips:



Keep generators **20 feet away** from the house, doors, & windows.



Power off & allow a **20-minute cooldown** before refueling.

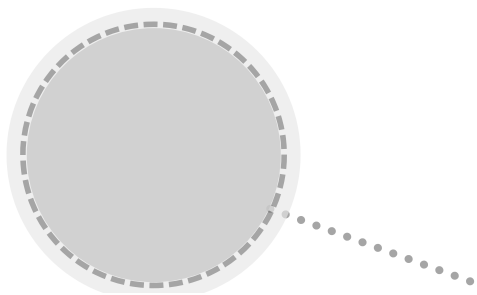


Purchase battery operated **\$20 alarm** to detect carbon monoxide.

More generator safety tips:



Keep dry

Do not use
generators in wet
conditions



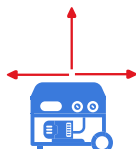
Avoid unsafe plugins

Never plug a generator
into wall outlets to
avoid feedback or
electrocution



Aim exhaust away

Aim generator
exhaust away from
buildings, open
windows, and vents.



Maintain clearance

Maintain at least 5
feet of clearance
above the generator
