Workshop new Climate Change Related Actions

- Add SOUL to any tree canopy-related actions
- Action 1: Add GNO Inc sustainable flood insurance to organizations
- Action 3: Add Urban Conservancy, DPW, Safety and Permits, Green Light New Orleans, Water Collaborative of Greater New Orleans, Housing Nola, and SOUL to organizations
 - Consider how this fee interacts with other water management-related fees (for example how this fee will impact nonprofits, etc.)
