

JUST RAIN DOWN THE DRAIN

CATCH BASINS serve as the entry point of our drainage system

BUILD UP of leaves and other debris will collect in front of and on top of your catch basin which may

BLOCK rain water from flowing into the drainage system and contribute to street flooding



3 simple steps to improve drainage

1. Remove leaves, grass and other visible debris in front of the catch basin opening and nearby area, especially before a rain storm
2. Place lawn clippings in garbage cans, and never blow, or sweep them down the catch basin
- 3 Encourage your neighbors to do the same

An interior cleaning requires a professional crew. Please do not attempt to lift catch basin lid or insert anything into the catch basin.

- Do not dispose of anything in the catch basin— especially grease, construction debris, or any toxic materials
- Avoid parking on the catch basin
